2024-2025 Tuition & Fee Schedule and Terms

Preschool

Registration fee: \$100 priority and preferred /\$150 non-priority non-refundable due at time of registration

Priority Enrollment is Nov 6 – Dec. 31

Preferred Enrollment is Nov 16 – Dec. 31

Open Enrollment begins January 3, 2024

Tuition:

Preschool 3yrs / 2 days per week = \$1500

Preschool 4yrs / 3 days per week = \$1800

Pre-Kindergarten / 3 full days per week = \$3000

Education fees*:

Preschool 3yrs = \$50

Preschool 4yrs = \$75

Pre-Kindergarten = \$100

Kindergarten – 8th grade

Registration fee: \$100 priority /\$150 non-priority non-refundable due at the time of registration

Priority Enrollment K-8 is Jan 3 – Feb 5

Open Enrollment K-8 begins Feb 5

Tuition: \$6200 per student

Tuition:

\$6,200 per year

Education fees*:

K – 2nd = \$150

3rd – 5th = \$200

6th – 7th = \$250

8th = \$275**

**8th grade = additional \$25 graduation fee

*Education fees include, but are limited to classroom consumable and project supplies, field trips, technology, etc.

All fees are due before student's first day of school and are non-refundable.

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All Tuition and Fees are paid through FACTS. In-School payments are not accepted.

All tuition and fees are paid through FACTS as follows:

EDUCATION FEES are due in full on June 1st

TUITION

1 annual payment on July 1st

2 semi-annual payments on July 1st & December 1st

10 monthly payments July 1st – April 1st

ALL tuition and fee payments must be made through FACTS. No exceptions.

We *strongly* encourage all families to apply for the Ohio EdChoice Expansion Scholarship to help cover \$650 - \$6165 of your child's Kindergarten – 8th grade tuition. education.ohio.gov
Funds received from this State scholarship are calculated based on attendance. If funds are released and applied to your child's account, but have not been earned due to withdrawal, the funds that have not been earned must be returned to the State of Ohio. Parents/guardians are responsible for any refunded amount required by the State.

Parishioners of St. Joseph and St. John Neumann are eligible for Parish Scholarship to help cover tuition amounts for students in grades K-8. This scholarship amount is meant to help cover the difference between the total tuition due of \$6200 and the EdChoice Expansion scholarship monies received from the State. Please contact your Parish to confirm your eligibility. Each family is responsible for notifying the School of their Parish affiliation and eligibility.

For St. Joseph and St. John Neumann parishioners, out of pocket tuition will not exceed \$3050 per child; which includes EdChoice Expansion Scholarship of \$650 or more, Parish Scholarship of \$2500, and parent contribution of \$3050.

Partial tuition assistance is also available for families who apply through the FACTS Grant & Aid portal as part of the Diocese of Cleveland. online.factsmgt.com

Special Scholarship Programs are available through the following:

Angel Scholarship Fund is an award from contributions that are not designated for a particular Diocesan school. All students enrolled in grades K-12 at a school in the Diocese of Cleveland are eligible to apply.



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Bishop's Scholarship for Excellence awards sixteen \$1,000 scholarships to 6th, 7th and 8th grade students in participating schools within the Diocese of Cleveland.

Tuition payments are expected to be made on a timely basis as scheduled. Delinquent payments will be subject to late fees. Please note the following regarding delinquent accounts:

- Report cards and/or diplomas will be withheld until all tuition and fees are paid to date.
- Transcripts of grades will not be released to any individual or educational institution unless all tuition and fees are paid to date.
- Registration for the next school year will be withheld if tuition and fees are not paid to date, as no tuition or fees can carry over from one year to the next.
- Students may be withheld from participating in field trips and extra-curricular activities if accounts are not paid to date.
- Students whose accounts are in arrears 30+ days may be dismissed.
- In the event of a student's withdrawal or dismissal after school has begun, tuition is due for each quarter that the student has been enrolled.

Parents/guardians agree to cooperate with the School to ensure that the monies from all scholarships and financial aid that their child/ren receive from outside sources to cover tuition and/or fees are transferred to the School, and will be responsible for these amounts if such funds are not received to the School for any reason.

Prepaid tuition will only be refunded if written notice of cancellation of this Agreement is received by the School before the first day of classes for the school year that is scheduled to start. All registration, education and other fees are non-refundable.
